International Yastrzhembskiy Conservation Award



Rules, Guidelines and Submission form



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1. Eligibility

- a. The award is open to individuals, groups, or organizations actively involved in conservation efforts.
- b. Applicants must demonstrate a significant impact on conservation in their community, region, or globally.
- c. Projects must be ongoing or recently completed (within the past two years).

2. **Application Process**

- a. Applicants must complete the official application form and provide all required information and supporting materials.
- b. All entries must be submitted by the deadline: 31st May 2025.
- c. Applications can be submitted online via mail to info@scimiddleeast.org

3. Project Criteria

- a. Projects must focus on conservation efforts such as habitat restoration, wildlife protection, sustainable practices, or environmental education.
- b. Projects should demonstrate measurable outcomes and impact.
- c. Innovation and use of best practices in conservation will be highly regarded.
- d. Community engagement and involvement are essential components of the project.

4. Selection Process

- a. An independent panel of experts in conservation and environmental science will review and evaluate all applications.
- b. The selection panel will consider the following factors:
 - i. Relevance and importance of the conservation issue addressed
 - ii. Effectiveness and impact of the project
 - iii. Innovation and uniqueness of the approach
 - iv. Sustainability and potential for long-term impact
 - v. Community engagement and involvement
- c. Shortlisted applicants may be required to provide additional information or participate in an interview.
- d. From all application will choice the jury five individuals or organistions embody the values and principles that define our conservation and hunting community. Their contributions have had a lasting and positive impact, making them highly deserving of this year's International Yastrzhembskiy Conservation Award. The winner will be announced during the award dinner and honored on stage.

5. Prizes

- a. Winner will receive a monetary grant to support their conservation work.
- b. Additional non-monetary prizes may include recognition plaques, certificates, and opportunities for publicity and networking.
- c. Winner will be announced at an official award ceremony, details of which will be communicated in advance.

6. Reporting and Accountability

- a. Award recipients must provide a detailed report on the use of the award funds within one year of receiving the award.
- b. Recipients may be required to present their projects at a future event or provide updates on their progress.

7. General Conditions

- a. The decision of the selection panel is final and binding.
- b. The organizing committee reserves the right to modify the rules and guidelines as necessary.
- c. By submitting an application, applicants agree to comply with all rules and guidelines and to participate in promotional activities related to the award.
