#### 1. Eligibility

- a. Open to photographers worldwide.
- b. Both amateur and professional photographers may apply.
- c. Applicants can submit a single image for each category.
- d. All photos must have been taken within the past three years.

#### 2. Award Categories:

- a. **Wildlife Photographer of the Year:** Celebrating an individual who has captured outstanding wildlife images that inspire action towards conservation and environmental awareness.
- b. **Young Wildlife Photographer of the Year:** Recognizing a young photographer (under 18) who demonstrates exceptional talent and creativity in wildlife photography.
- c. Conservation Photography Award: Highlighting a photographer who focuses on wildlife conservation issues, documenting the challenges and efforts made to protect endangered species and habitats.
- d. **Urban Wildlife Photography Award:** Recognizing a photographer who captures the interaction between wildlife and urban environments, showcasing the resilience of animals in the face of human development.
- e. **Behavioral Wildlife Award:** Awarding a photographer who documents unique, rare, or incredible wildlife behaviors in their natural habitats.

#### 3. Application Process

- a. Submit your application via the official submission form.
- b. Via **email**, at the address (info@scimiddleeast.org) provide high-resolution digital files (JPEG or TIFF format) per entry for each award category.
- c.Include a short description (up to 200 words) for each photograph, explaining the context, location, and significance of the image.
- d. Include supporting materials such as photo stories, behind-the-scenes videos, or testimonials (optional).
- e. All entries must be submitted by the deadline: 31st May 2025.

#### 4. Award Criteria:

- a. **Visual Impact and Creativity:** the artistic composition, lighting, and uniqueness of the captured moment
- b. Technical Excellence: Mastery of photographic techniques such as focus, exposure, and framing.
- c. **Conservation Message:** How effectively the photograph communicates a message about wildlife conservation and environmental protection (especially for the Conservation Photography Award).
- d. **Ethical Considerations:** Photographs must not disturb or harm wildlife. The welfare of animals should be prioritized, and entrants must adhere to ethical wildlife photography practices.

#### 5. Judging Panel:

a. A panel of internationally acclaimed photographers, conservationists, and wildlife experts will review all submissions. The panel will evaluate five finalists from each category, with winners announced at the official award ceremony.

#### 6. Prizes:

- a. Category winners will recieve an award plaque, and be featured in a dedicated exhibition during the award ceremony. Winning photographs will also be showcased in our annual report, website, and social media platforms.
- b. Additional non-monetary prizes may include recognition plaques, certificates, and opportunities for publicity and networking.
- c. Winner will be announced at an official award ceremony, details of which will be communicated in advance.

#### 7. General Conditions

- a. The decision of the selection panel is final and binding.
- b. The organizing committee reserves the right to modify the rules and guidelines as necessary.
- c.a Copy of the winning photo for each category will be put on auction during the Award ceremony
- d. By submitting an application, applicants agree to comply with all rules and guidelines and to participate in promotional activities related to the award.
